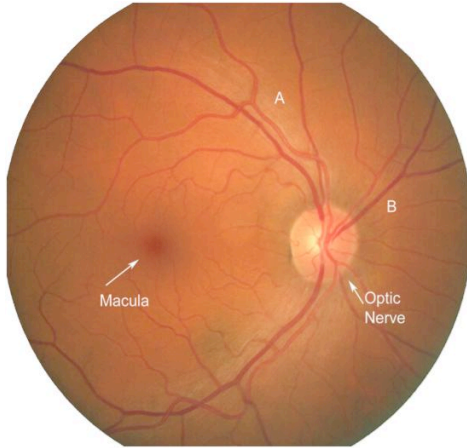

Fundus Photography

Description of Procedure

The retinal fundus is the interior lining of the eyeball and is the area that can be seen through the pupil during an eye examination. Our Digital Retinal Camera allows us to take photographs of the back of your eye. This enables a far more detailed examination than was previously possible. The image is captured using flash photography and nothing touches the eye. We then have a permanent and accurate record stored for future comparisons. The resultant images will become part of the patient's permanent record. Fundus photographs are taken through a dilated pupil in order to enhance the quality of the record. Fundus photography is used to document abnormalities of the eye.
